

DIRECTIONS & TRAVEL INFORMATION

Arriving by Train

Metro-North Railroad Harlem Line commuter trains run approximately every half-hour between 6 a.m. and 11:30 p.m. on weekdays, and hourly on weekends. Take the train from Grand Central Terminal (Lexington Avenue and 42nd Street in Manhattan) to the Bronxville Station. Purchase your round-trip tickets at the station to avoid an extra charge on board. Please call Metro-North [(800) METROGO or (800) 638-7646], visit the Metro-North site at www.mnr.org, or inquire at the information booth in Grand Central Terminal for exact schedule and fare information. Taxi service is available at the Bronxville Station for the short ride to the College (ask to be taken to Westlands Gate).

Arriving by Plane

Airport Shuttle Service: Various trip services are dispatched from the ground transportation booths located behind baggage claim areas in all major airports. Private sedans, vans, and limousines are offered, as are scheduled shuttles to Manhattan and Westchester County locations and shared door-to-door service.

Airport Bus Service: Westchester Express [(866) 914-6800 or (718) 276-6020] runs van service between Westlands Gate and LaGuardia and Kennedy airports between 5 a.m. and 6 p.m., seven days a week [www.westchesterexpress.net]. A 24-hour advance reservation is required. New York Airport Service [(718) 875-8200] runs buses between Kennedy and LaGuardia and Manhattan [www.nyairportservice.com]. Newark Liberty Airport Express [(877) 8NEWARK or (908) 354-3330] runs buses between Newark Airport and Manhattan [www.coachusa.com/olympia/ss.newarkairport.asp]. Service is frequent and boarding points at airline terminals are clearly marked. For those who wish to make connections with Metro-North commuter trains, stops are conveniently located within a block of Grand Central Terminal.

Parking Information

Parking is limited at Sarah Lawrence during the academic year.

Weekdays (Monday to Friday) from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Please proceed to Westlands Gate off of Mead Way, and Security will either inform you of the best place to park or issue a temporary parking pass.

Weeknights (Monday to Friday) after 5 p.m., guest parking is permitted in any lot without a permit. We recommend parking during these times in Andrews Parking Lot, an immediate right-hand turn off Glen Washington Road.

Weekends (Saturday and Sunday) all day and evening, parking is permitted in any lot without a permit. We recommend parking during these times in Andrews Parking Lot, an immediate right-hand turn off Glen Washington Road.

If you have the luxury of time during the academic year and you're a senior in high school, we also encourage you to sit in on a class or stay overnight with a current student.

Office of Admission Hours

The Office of Admission is open year-round from Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.

During the fall semester, the Office is open on Saturdays from October 3 through December 12, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Office hours are limited from August 24 to September 20, and from December 18 through January 18. Please call ahead to check availability.

Information Sessions

We offer 30-minute sessions with an admission representative to familiarize you with key elements of our unique academic system and our application process at Sarah Lawrence. Information sessions are offered twice daily at 9:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. Please call in advance to schedule a session.

Campus Tours

Student-led campus tours are offered during the academic year at 10 a.m., noon, and 2 p.m. During the summer, tours are offered at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. The tour lasts approximately 75 minutes. Please call in advance to schedule a tour.

Personal Interviews (for seniors and transfers)

Personal interviews are not a required part of the Sarah Lawrence application process, but they can provide an opportunity for students to talk individually with an admission representative to learn more about the College. You should think of the interview not as a trial to be endured but as an opportunity to interview us—to ask the questions you want to ask, to meet personally with someone who knows the College well, and to get a sense of how your needs and interests would be met by Sarah Lawrence. Current SLC seniors or admission staff members conduct interviews on campus, while our alumnae/i conduct off-campus interviews. *Please note that if you are unable to interview on campus or meet with an alumnae/i interviewer, this will not be held against you in the admission process.*

On-campus interviews are available, by appointment, for first-year applicants from April through mid-December, and for transfer applicants from April through February. Call the Office of Admission for our summer interview schedule. Saturday interviews are available, by appointment, from October through mid-December and again in April. If you are not able to visit campus, you may contact our office to request an alumnae/i interview. Alumnae/i interviews are available from April through January for first-year applicants, and from April through February for transfer applicants.

Class Visits (for seniors and transfers)

Seniors and transfers are welcome to sit in on a class during their visit to campus. There is no better way to get a feel for the academic culture of Sarah Lawrence. If you are interested in scheduling a class visit, please call the Office of Admission at least two weeks prior to your visit to reserve a space.

Class visits are available from October through early December and February through April. Please plan to stay for the duration of the class session. Due to the small size of our courses and the large number of requests we receive, only prospective students may visit classes and only one class visit per student.

Overnight Visits (for seniors and transfers)

During the academic year, high school seniors and transfer applicants are invited to stay overnight on campus to experience a day in the life of a Sarah Lawrence student. Overnight visits are scheduled for Monday through Wednesday nights and are available from October through mid-December and February through April. If you are interested in scheduling an overnight visit, please call the Office of Admission at least two weeks in advance.
